Brush out well and finish in one direction.

 A second coat may be required if painting over a very dark colour with a light top coat or when applying a light colour to an extremely porous substrate, i.e. MDF or chipboard. Allow 16 hours between coats.

COVERAGE AND DRY TIMES • 8m² per litre. Touch dry in 1-2 hours.
Overcoat after 16 hours if required. • Low temperature, high humidity or poor ventilation may extend drying and recoat times.

CLEAN UP • Remove as much product as possible from application equipment prior to cleaning. Clean brushes with brush cleaner or white spirit.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE • Clean surfaces with a detergent solution. • Avoid abrasive cleaners.
