What is Ronseal Decking Oil?

Ronseal Decking Oil provides timber decking with a light natural tint, retaining the beauty of the wood to show through. It is specially designed to be used on quality timber decking, to help prevent drying and splitting. It provides a protective barrier against water penetration where constant weathering can cause swelling and warping. Not only does Ronseal Decking Oil enhance your decks beauty and provide superb protection, it also allows your deck to be in use within 24 hours.

Where can Ronseal Decking Oil be used?

Ronseal Decking Oil will waterproof and protect any hardwood or softwood decking timber including pre-treated, pressure treated or preservative impregnated timber.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

NB: Only specially pre-treated, pressure treated or preservative impregnated timber should be used to build decking. Always test an unobtrusive area before starting general application of Ronseal Decking Oil to ensure desired result is achieved.

PREPARATION

Decking timber should be free from dust, dirt, oil, mildew, algae and other contaminants. Some pre-treatments may affect adhesion of decking products. Test by splashing water on timber, if beading occurs, allow a period of weathering and re-test prior to application. Treatment of a small inconspicuous test area to determine colour and adhesion is strongly recommended. For best results, clean surface with Ronseal Decking Cleaner before application and allow to dry thoroughly. All previous coatings must be completely removed before applying Ronseal Decking Oil. Final finish may differ to pack representation due to colour, texture and porosity of the wood.

APPLICATION

Do not apply in wet conditions or if rain or frost is likely before product is dry.

1. Important: Decking boards should be completely dry before application.
2. Shake Ronseal Decking Oil thoroughly before pouring into a suitable metal or plastic container. Stir before and during use. Do not dilute.
3. Apply a "flood" coat of Ronseal Decking Oil using a good quality bristle brush or roller.
4. Apply a second coat using the same method. Allow 6 hours between coats. (number of coats required will depend on timber type and absorbency).

DRYING TIME

Ronseal Decking Oil can be recoated in 6 hours. The deck will be ready for general use after 24 hours. Drying time will vary depending on climate conditions and porosity of the timber.

COVERAGE

This 2.5 litre pack is normally sufficient to coat a deck 10-12m² with 2 coats of Decking Oil. Coverage will vary with absorbency of timber and profile of deck.

CLEAN UP

Clean all brushes using white spirit or paint brush cleaner immediately. Remove as much product as possible from application equipment before cleaning. Some local authorities have special facilities for disposing of waste products. Do not empty into drains or watercourses.

MAINTENANCE

Decking treated with Ronseal Decking Oil can be cleaned using Ronseal Decking Cleaner. The coating should be inspected on a 6 monthly basis. Re-coat as appropriate.
