HOW MANY COATS? 3 coat application.

DRYING TIMES Dry time 30 mins. Recoat 2 hours.

COVERAGE 2.5 litres is normally sufficient to cover 40-60m² with one coat. Dependent on the porosity or species of the wood.

PREPARATION New floors: Sand the floor in the direction of the grain with 120 grit sand paper, either by hand or by machine. Vacuum the floor to remove dirt and dust. Wipe down with white spirit to remove fine dust and allow to dry thoroughly before coating with Ronseal Floor Oil. Use Ronseal Floor Oil as directed. Wear a mask whilst sanding to avoid the inhalation of dust. Previously Oiled Floors: Vacuum the floor to remove dirt and dust.
