

Ronseal Kitchen & Bathroom Repair Kit contains everything you need for the easy and professional repair of cracks, scratches, and defects on kitchen and bathroom fixtures and appliances.

Repair kit contents: • Repair compound and hardener

• Touch up enamel with brush applicator • Sandpaper • Mixing spatula

USAGE AREAS

- For use on enamelled cast iron and steel, porcelain, fibreglass, acrylic and other similar material.
- Instantaneous repair of kitchen and bathroom fixtures and appliances e.g. Sinks, Washing Machines, Baths, Ceramic Tiles, Refrigerators, Shower Stalls and hard water damage.

PREPARATION

- It is not recommended to use this product in damp conditions or if temperature is below 0°C.
- Surfaces should be clean, dry and free from dust, dirt and grease. Remove any rust spots or loose material.

APPLICATION

- Mix the required amount of repair compound and a little hardener at a 30-to-1 ratio. Only 1g of the hardener would be required to mix with the 30g of repair compound. Apply the filler to the damaged area and allow it to dry for 30 minutes.
- Next, use the **brown sandpaper** for enamel and porcelain items, until the surface is smooth and there are no more projections or holes. For acrylic and fibreglass surfaces it is important to use the **grey wet/dry sandpaper** with water. Thoroughly clean off all sanding dust.
- Shake the touch-up enamel vigorously for two minutes. **Hold upright when opening.**

- Apply the enamel coating in multiple thin coats.
- **Important: In order to achieve 100% hardness do not use water on the repaired surface for 4 days.**

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean surfaces with a detergent solution.
- Do not use concentrated/abrasive cleaners or organic solvents on the repaired area.
- Heat resistant to 60°C
