What is Ronseal Teak Oil?

Ronseal Teak Oil naturally nourishes, protects and enhances all types of hardwood garden furniture. By deeply penetrating the wood to replace oils lost through weathering, Ronseal Teak Oil restores old garden furniture as well as protecting and maintaining the appearance of new hardwood garden furniture.

Where can I use it?

Ronseal Teak Oil is ideal for use on all types of hardwood garden furniture including Teak.

Preparation

Remove all previous coatings such as paint, varnish and woodstain. Lightly sand to remove any loose wood fibres. Avoid the inhalation of dust, wear a suitable face mask when sanding. Remove dust, dirt and grease by wiping over with white spirit. Always test for finish on a small inconspicuous area.

Application

1. Ensure surface is dry and clean.
2. Apply liberally using a soft, dry, lint free cloth.
3. Work lightly into grain. Wipe off any excess.
4. Re-apply as necessary once the previous coat has dried.
5. Three coats will provide adequate protection. Leave to dry overnight between coats.

Maintain regularly with a further coat of Ronseal Teak Oil to ensure lasting protection.

Drying Times

In good weather conditions Ronseal Teak Oil is touch dry in 6 hours.

Clean Up

Warning: cloths and soiled rags may self ignite without warning. Wash out well in warm soapy water before disposal. Some local authorities have special facilities for the disposal of waste products. Do not empty into drains or watercourses. Ensure container is fully re-sealed after use.
